

Articles of Association of the Carlisle High School Alumni Association

We, the undersigned, acting as duly elected agents, being persons over the age of twenty-one years, citizens of the United States of America, and residents of the State of Arkansas, for the purpose of founding and continuing this association do hereby certify as follows:

First

The name of the association is the Carlisle High School Alumni Association.

Second

The period of the duration of the association shall be perpetual.

Third

This association shall be for the public benefit. The purposes for which the association is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

Fourth

The powers and purposes of this association shall be:

1. Promote a spirit of alumni unity and camaraderie through communication and reunions among alumni.
2. Locate alumni and maintain a current database of said alumni.
3. To actively support and promote the Carlisle schools within the community, especially in funding scholarships for students, and promoting general fellowship and community involvement with the school.
4. To provide a source of historical information about Carlisle Public Schools and the City of Carlisle through the acquisition and maintenance of memorabilia and historical artifacts.
5. To manage its internal affairs in any way, so long as the provisions of the law are not violated.
6. To do any and all things necessary, convenient, useful, or incidental to the attainment of its purposes as fully and to the same extent as natural persons lawfully might or could do so long as consistent with the provisions of the law.
7. To make and amend the by-laws not inconsistent with these Articles of Association or with the laws of the State of Arkansas for regulating and managing the affairs of the association.

8. To take, manage, hold and dispose of property, whether real or person, of the said association, no part of the income from which is to be distributed to the members or officers of this association.
9. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this association shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by any organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

Fifth

This association shall have such powers as are necessary to carry out its stated purposes as allowed under the laws of the state of Arkansas and under guidelines of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue involved.

Sixth

Upon the dissolution of the association, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all of the liabilities of the association, dispose of all of the assets of the association exclusively for the purposes of the association in such manner, or to such charitable, educational, religious, literary, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue involved, as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Chancery Court of the county in which the principal office of the association is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organization, as said Court shall determine, which are organized exclusively for such purposes.

Seventh

The Board of Directors of this association shall be elected by the membership of the association consistent with guidelines specified in the by-laws of the association.

Eighth

Membership in the association will consist of three levels as specified in the by-laws of the association.
