1. **ALL CONTESTANTS** *must* bring at least two (2) gallons of Chili already prepared and in your own containers. Three (3) gallons of chili are recommended to permit everyone to taste your chili.
2. **ALL CONTESTANTS** must be at the Carlisle Elementary Cafeteria not later than 4:00 P.M. on February 11, 2012 to reserve space assignments and get set up for opening to the public at 5:00 P.M.
3. **ALL CONTESTANTS** must clean up each space assigned after completion of serving of chili.
4. Bowls, spoons, napkins, crackers, tea and water will be provided. Hot Dogs, soft drinks, and desserts will be available for purchase.
5. Entries can be mailed or delivered to the Carlisle High School Alumni Association by **February 3, 2012** . No entries will be accepted after that date.
6. No LP stoves - Coleman stoves may be used. Electricity will be available. Please bring your own heavy-duty extension cords, power strips, etc. Due to space limitations, please do not use "pop up" tents. You should plan for a 6" table space.
7. Each chili team should have a unique name and plan the decorations for their booth around a theme. Remember, there will be a special award for "Best Decorated Booth".
