

Minutes for November 12th, 2000

President Peggy Bailey called the meeting to order and thanked those present for attending.

There were no minutes from the last meeting in October.

The treasurer reported that deposits made from February 2000 through November 2000 totaled \$10,993.87, expenses totaled \$2,907.17, leaving a balance of \$8,086.70.

We have 408 members, 112 one year memberships and 296 lifetime memberships. \$200 has been received in memorials.

Peggy handed out a questionnaire, which asked for suggestions on any changes that should be made to improve the weekend activities. Some ideas raised were; more Alumni members taking part in the entertainment, finding a theme for the weekend, getting the date for Homecoming as soon as possible, better location for the registration tent and getting the food vendors closer together, having tents for school memorabilia, one tent for the 20s,30s and 40s, one for the 50s, 60s, 70s and one for the 80s, 90, 2000, and get volunteers from those classes to take care of notifying their classmates to help. It was decided to keep the raffle. It was brought up about having something for people to do after the Saturday afternoon activities, maybe a dance that night and have fish catered. Olivia suggested we look into having a golf tournament to raise money, maybe the Thursday before Alumni Weekend. She will contact Bill and Dixie Shoup and get some information.

Olivia will also get in touch with Nancy Kittler about being publicity chairman. A scholarship committee has to be appointed. Carolyn will check and see how we need to go about selecting our recipient.

A motion was made and seconded to give a check to the First Baptist Church in the amount of \$100 for the use of Downs Hall, and to the city, for park improvements, in the amount of \$250.

Election of officers, Committee Chairs, and a Charter was discussed.

The next meeting will be January 21st.
