

CHS Alumni Board Meeting

The CHS Alumni Board Meeting was called to order by the President, Mike Calvert with twelve members present.

Treasurer Gina Ingle reported income and expenses for the weekend with a balance of \$935.68, but several bills are outstanding. Balance in the History fund is \$796.95 which included the donation from class of 1946 cookbook sales. Mike suggested we allocate from their funds a \$360 Black & Gold scholarship in honor of that class. 75 more cookbooks are being printed and will be for sale.

Bobbie Pryor reported 34 new lifetime members (including 3 associate) and 7 one year members. Total registered for Friday and Saturday was 433.

The group voted to pay James Gosney \$250 for equipment and set up for Saturday.

Mike had talked to the representative from First Electric, which are giving the Alumni a grant for \$500.

The group discussed the weekend and voiced compliments and complaints and what we can do better next year. Each board member was asked to write their suggestions down so that they can be remembered when we start planning Homecoming 2007.

Mike reminded members that we will sponsor the Fish Fry on December 4th after the Christmas Parade. It will take place in Downs Hall, First Baptist Church. Tickets for Adults will be \$10.00.

No further business, the meeting adjourned.

OLD BUSINESS – Treasurer Gina Ingle reported a profit of \$208.23 from the Fish Fry after the Chamber of Commerce Christmas Parade with an attendance of 216. Everyone agreed that we should not do the mail out to Alumni members or the newspaper ad inviting them to the fish fry since a free announcement is made in the Carlisle Independent. It was not felt that the mail out and purchased ad brought enough additional people to the event to offset the costs.

Alumni Weekend Date – is October 20-21, 2006.

Highlighted Classes for 2006 Alumni Weekend – Classes to be highlighted this year are 1996, 1986, 1976, 1966, 1956, 1946. Historian Olivia Kegley continues to receive more information and articles donated and suggestions from the classes to be highlighted.

Honorary Alumni – After discussion, Janet Pasley made a motion that each year a maximum of three individuals be recognized as honorary alumni. Motion seconded and carried.

Town Meeting – There will be a town meeting Thursday, January 26 to discuss the building of a school building and community center. Three individuals from Austin TX will be here to discuss what they did using a joint effort between the school district and city to build a school and community center. Other visitors will be some State Department of Education representatives and several legislators.
