

**CHS Alumni Association  
Minutes  
September 17, 2006**

President Mike Calvert called the meeting to order with 11 members present.

Bobbie Jean Pryor made a motion to accept the minutes from the last meeting. Motion seconded and carried.

Treasurer Gina Ingle reported a balance of \$3813.68 in checking, with \$1310.00 designated for history, and a certificate of deposit for \$1250. The Treasurer's report was accepted as presented.

Membership Chair Bobby Jean Pryor reported 556 members—521 life members, 7 one-year members, 11 associate members, and 17 honorary members.
